

The Promised Messiah

Isaiah Chapter 53

“All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all.”

Isaiah 53:6

Introduction: Isaiah 52:13-15 (*“My servant shall be high and lifted up, and shall be exalted.”* 52:13)

Despised By Men (Verses 1-3)

“He was despised and rejected by men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief; and as one from whom men hide their faces; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.” Vs. 3

Disciplined By God (Verses 4-6)

“But he was wounded for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his stripes we are healed.” Vs. 5

Denied By Self (Verses 7-9)

“He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth; like a lamb that is led to the slaughter, and like a sheep that before its shearers is silent, so he opened not his mouth.” Vs.

Conclusion: Isaiah 53:10-12 (*“By his knowledge shall the righteous one, my servant, make many to be accounted righteous, and he shall bear their iniquities.”* 53:11)
