John Chapter 11

Jesus said to her, "Did I not tell you that if you believed you would see the glory of God?" John 11:40

Do you see the Gory of God in the Face of Suffering, Sickness, Grief; even Death?

"This illness does not lead to death. It is for the glory of God, so that the Son of God may be glorified through it." John 11:4

Do you see the Gory of God in the Face of Disappointments & Confusion?

"Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died."
Martha & Mary both; John 11:21 & 32

Do you see the Gory of God in the Face of Impossible Situations & Promises?

Now when Jesus came, he found that Lazarus had already been in the tomb four days. John 11:17

Jesus said to her, "Your brother will rise again." John 11:23

Do you see the Gory of God in the Face of Unreasonable Requests?

Then after this he said to the disciples, "Let us go to Judea again."

The disciples said to him, "Rabbi, the Jews were just now seeking to stone you, and are you going there again?" John 11:7-8

Jesus said, "Take away the stone." Martha, the sister of the dead man, said to him, "Lord, by this time there will be an odor, for he has been dead four days." John 11:39
