Bodily Cleansing

If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. For I have given you an example, that you also should do just as I have done to you. Truly, truly, I say to you, a servant is not greater than his master... Vs. 14-16

Bountiful Cleansing

Jesus said to him, “The one who has bathed does not need to wash, except for his feet, but is completely clean. And you are clean, but not every one of you.” Vs. 10

Body of Christ Cleansing

*For he knew who was to betray him; that was why he said, “Not all of you are clean.” Vs. 11 (Judas)
So, after receiving the morsel of bread, he immediately went out. And it was night. Vs. 30 (Judas)*

Washing One Another in Love

When Jesus knew that his hour had come to depart out of this world to the Father, having loved his own who were in the world, he loved them to the end. Verse 1

“A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another.” Verses 34-35
