“As they were going along the road they came to some water, and the eunuch said, ‘See, here is water! What prevents me from being baptized?’” Acts 8:36

Why?

“...to bring about the obedience of faith for the sake of his name among all the nations.” Romans 1:5

“...according to the command of the eternal God, to bring about the obedience of faith.” Romans 16:26

How?

“They both went down into the water...” Acts 8:38

“When he came up out of the water...” Mark 1:10
