The Words of Jesus

“If I am not doing the works of my Father, then do not believe me; but if I do them, even though you do not believe me, believe the works, that you may know and understand that the Father is in me and I am in the Father.” John 10:37-38

The Witnesses of Jesus

“He who saw it has borne witness—his testimony is true, and he knows that he is telling the truth—that you also may believe.” John 19:35

The Writing of John

“Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; but these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.” John 20:30-31
